IF THE DECISION TO EVACUATE IS MADE, PARENTS MUST PICK UP THE CHILDREN FROM SCHOOL

PARENTS/SUBSTITUTES MUST PICK UP THE CHILDREN FROM THEIR HOME CLASSROOMS. IF THE STUDENTS ARE IN THE SPORTS CENTRE, THEY MUST BE PICKED UP THERE. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT STUDENTS WHO ARE ON THEIR WAY TO OR FROM THE SPORTS CENTER CONTINUE AND WALK WHERE THEY WERE SUPPOSED TO GO, NOT TURN AROUND OR GO STRAIGHT HOME.

NO CHILD WILL BE SENT OUT UNACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT/SUBSTITUTE.

AN EMPLOYEE WILL BE AT THE SCHOOL UNTIL ALL STUDENTS HAVE BEEN PICKED UP OR TAKEN TO A SAFE PLACE (SPORTS CENTER, MUSEUM CENTER) IN COOPERATION WITH THE POLICE OR A RESCUE TEAM.

PARENTS MUST EXPECT A LOT OF TRAFFIC IN GRINDAVÍK, AND ESPECIALLY NEAR THE SCHOOL IF THERE IS AN EVACUATION DURING SCHOOL HOURS.

PARENTS CAN BE ADVISED THAT IT WILL EVEN BE QUICKER TO ARRIVE ON FOOT.

THE POLICE WILL TRY TO CONTROL TRAFFIC AT SCHOOLS AND KINDERGARTENS IN CASE OF EVACUATION

IF THE STUDENTS ARE NOT PICKED UP AT THE SCHOOL BUILDING OR THE SPORTS CENTER, THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR WILL TAKE THEM TO THE COLLECTION AREA (SPORTS CENTER).
